This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 to take legal action against the private respondent, who is destroying the matrimonial life of the petitioner with further direction to decide the representation dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P/1) submitted by petitioner and to register FIR under appropriate Section of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 13.12.2019 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/1, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into and decide representation dated 13.12.2019 (Annexure P/1) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
