The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') praying for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 11.07.2019, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is a wholesale chemist and he had purchased the medicines from Neutec Healthcare Pvt. Ltd. New Delhi, which is the subject matter of the FIR and was sold by him to one BMW Medicos, Maur Mandi under valid licence and he has supplied all the documents and fully cooperated with the investigation process.

On 06.09.2019, while issuing notice of motion, interim protection was granted to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying with the provisions enshrined under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dharminster Paal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and that he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Interim order dated September 06, 2019, is hereby made absolute.
