In compliance of order dated 13.02.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.128 dated 18.09.2007, registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506, 201, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Ropar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 09.09.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 07.02.2020 to get their statements recorded. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.145 dated 07.02.2020, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, vide Endst. No.2031 dated 11.02.2020

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is with their own sweet will, voluntarily and without any pressure or coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.128 dated 18.09.2007, registered under Sections 353, 186, 332, 506, 201, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Ropar, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarter concerned.
