The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.599 dated 12.07.2020 under Sections 21, 27-A and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, the NDPS Act) registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Perusal of the order dated 11.11.2020 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Judge, Special Court, Kurukshetra, shows that apart from the fact that co-accused Baljinder Kaur has disclosed that she used to purchase the contraband from the petitioner, the petitioner is involved

in three other cases under the NDPS Act. Therefore, this Court finds that no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
