The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.247 dated 14.05.2020 under Sections 21, 27-A and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, the NDPS Act) registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Perusal of the order dated 12.11.2020 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra, shows that the petitioner has supplied the drugs to co-accused for Rs.15,000/-. Moreover, three more cases i.e. (i) FIR No.155 dated 30.03.2017 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Sadar Thanesar, (ii) FIR No.599 dated 12.07.2020 under

Sections 21, 27-A and 29 of the NDPS Act, Police Station City Thanesar and (iii) FIR No.110 dated 27.10.2020 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Pehowa are pending against the petitioner. Therefore, this Court finds that no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
