This writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of order dated 25.05.2015 (Annexure P1) passed by learned Appellate Authority-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Jagraon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that half of the amount demanded by the Department stood deposited in the year 2010 while deposit of rest of the amount was stayed in this writ petition, at the time of issuance of notice of motion. However, the petitioner, it is submitted, has deposited the entire demanded amount as detailed in Annexure P6 attached with CM-3155-2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the deposit of the amount by way of full and final settlement with the respondent -authorities, this writ petition be disposed of accordingly.

Learned counsel for the respondent - authorities verifies the deposit of the said amount and on instructions submits that no other amount is due from the petitioner in this respect.

Keeping in view the fact and circumstances as above, no further orders are called for in this writ petition.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
