Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 4 and 5 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and further issuance of direction to respondents No.4 to 12 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that respondent No.6 Chhinda Singh-father of petitioner No.1-Gurpreet Kaur, has made statement that he has no objection regarding the marriage of the petitioners as he is aware of their marriage and will not interfere in the lives of the petitioners and the present petition, thus, become infructuous.

In view of the above-mentioned statement, the instant petition is disposed of as such.
