After arguing at some length, counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw present petition with liberty to avail his remedy before Debts Recovery Tribunal. He, however, submits that he may be dispossessed from the property and in such eventuality, he would be rendered homeless.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. In case the appeal is barred by limitation, the petitioner would be entitled to move an application for condonation thereof, if maintainable.,

Status quo regarding possession shall, however, be maintained for a period of two weeks from today.

Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as an opinion of this Court on merits.
