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1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Joint application has been moved for disposal of the appeal on the basis of amicable settlement, whereby the Insurance Company/respondent No.3 has agreed to enhance the compensation from Rs.1,85,000/- already awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Hoshiarpur by Rs.3,15,000/- to be paid within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order disposing of the main appeal.
3. Application is duly supported with an affidavit of Manjit Kaur, widow of Sukhwinder Singh (mother of deceased Manwinder Singh aged 4 ½ years).

4. Learned counsel for the parties pray for disposal of the appeal in terms of the joint application.

5. Accordingly, in view of the joint application as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the application is allowed. Main appeal is preponed to today and taken on board.

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6. In view of the order passed in CM No.7279-CII of 2020 above as also the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the appeal is disposed of in terms of the settlement as per joint application. Resultantly, the Insurance Company/respondent No.3 would make additional payment of Rs.3,15,000/- within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, through RTGS in the bank account of the appellant subject to fulfillment of all formalities by the appellant.
