23 Petitioners were employed on Teaching & Non
Teaching Jobs in the Adarsh Senior Secondary School, Village
Midduman, Tehsil & District Faridkot-respondent no.5 in the year
2011-12 as per details furnished in para no.2 of the writ petition.

The said Adarsh School and other such schools in the state of

Punjab were established under the Punjab Education Development

Board Act, 1998. Admittedly the petitioners were employed under the management of a private partner i.e. respondent no.6. They have laid challenge to the amendment made vide Notification dated 10.01.2008 (P-2), whereby the State Govt. has been given the right to associate the private persons to establish and run such Adarsh Schools under the Public Private Partnership (PPP) Mode.

It is evident that the petitioners were the beneficiaries of such amendment at the time of initial appointment.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the present writ petition.
