Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite the statement given by the counsel for the State in CWP No. 5488 of 2009 on 29.07.2009, petitioner has not been granted the consequential benefits notionally.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that as per the reply, which has been filed by the District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Ludhiana dated 30.05.2018, the consequential benefits, except for seniority, have been granted to the petitioner. He asserts that although in the reply, which has been filed, it has been stated that the benefit of seniority has also been granted to her and her seniority has been re-fixed but the petitioner does not know her seniority number.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Dharmpal

Singh, O/o District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Ludhiana,

submits that the seniority number of the petitioner is 5230-A which is as per her date of appointment which has now been fixed as 09.12.2006. This renders the writ petition infructuous.

Disposed of as such.
