The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners and also issuance of direction to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners and further issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to allow respondents No.4 to 6 or anybody else to interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector Jagsir Singh, submits that respondents No.4 to 6 have made statements regarding the fact that they will not interfere in the life of the petitioners and the present petition becomes infructuous.

In view of above, the instant petition stands disposed of as such.
