The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners at the behest of respondent No.4 and other relatives and friends.

The contents of the petition alongwith Annexures thereof have been perused. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh that the contents of the representation dated 21.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) seeking protection of life and liberty be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall neither be treated as a stamp of this Court qua marriage of the petitioners nor any reflection on the merits of the contentions raised by them in the present petition.
