GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

(1) The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner – Kuldeep Saini, *inter alia*, with the prayer to direct the respondents to decide the appeal dated 16.06.2017 (P1) filed by him before the Appellate Authority, DIG, Ludhiana, Range, Ludhiana.

(2) The record shows that on 19.05.2018, notice of motion was issued and thereafter on 13.08.2018 reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Kailash Chander, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2. Still further, on 13.08.2018 reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Gursharan Singh Sandhu, IPS, Dy. Inspector General of Police, Ludhiana Range, Ludhiana - respondent No.4 was filed. Thereafter on 11.08.2018, short reply was filed by Sh. Snehdeep Sharma, PPS, (Ex.SSP SBS Nagar) now AIG Special Task Force, Ludhiana Range. Again on 13.08.2018 reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Satinder Singh, PPS, Sr.Suptd. of Police, SBS Nagar - respondent No.6 was filed.

(3) Today, a short affidavit of Sh. Ashok Kumar, PPS, DSP Phillaur on behalf of respondent No.3 dated 18.02.2020 has been filed.

(4) Today on the resumed hearing of the case, learned State counsel has furnished a copy of the order dated 17.02.2020 passed by the Inspector General of Police which is taken on record. Vide this order, the appeal of the petitioner has been accepted and the order dated 18.05.2017 has been set aside.

(5) In view of the fact that substantial relief already stands granted to the petitioner, no further order is called for.

(6) The writ petition disposed of as infructuous.
