By this common order, both the writ petitions details of which have been given in the heading of this order, are being decided as both the writ petitions involve the same question of law and similar facts. For the purpose of this order, the facts are being taken from CWP No.9622 of 2017.

Challenge in this writ petition is to the charge-sheet dated 30.10.2015 and the subsequent proceedings on the ground that the respondent-Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd. has no jurisdiction to continue with the disciplinary proceedings after the retirement of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that this Court while deciding CWP No.5254 of 2005 along with other bunch of cases on 30.09.2019, titled as “*Nirmal Singh vs Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd (PUNSUP)*”, has already decided the question of law, which has been raised in the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly concedes that the question of law in these writ petitions already stands answered by this Court in *Nirmal Singh's* case (*supra*) and the respondent- Corporation has no objection in case, the present writ petitions are disposed of in the same terms.

Keeping in view the request made by learned counsel for the parties, the aforesaid two writ petitions are disposed of in terms of CWP No.5254 of 2005, titled as “*Nirmal Singh vs Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd (PUNSUP)*” decided on 30.09.2019.
