Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and further issuance of direction to respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

The contents of the petition alongwith Annexures thereof have been perused. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib that the contents of the representation dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) seeking protection of life and liberty be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall neither be treated as a stamp of this Court qua marriage of the petitioners nor any reflection on the merits of the contentions raised by them in the present petition.
