The petitioners have approached this Court seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to include the name of the petitioners in the list of candidates called for scrutiny of documents for the post of VLDA which has been advertised on 10.07.2015 (Annexure P-2).

On 19.01.2017, notice of motion was issued and thereafter vide order dated 24.01.2017, respondents were directed to consider the claim of the petitioners provisionally subject to their right to oppose the present petition. The petitioners thereafter were interviewed.

As per the reply filed by respondent No.2, the candidature of petitioner No. 1-Anish Kumar was rejected because he had scratched the answer of question No. 92 on OMR sheet (Annexure R-2/2). Similarly petitioner No.2-Sonu Kumar scratched the answer of question No. 41 on OMR sheet which is in violation of the conditions of the answer sheet

(Annexure R-2/1). Alongwith reply, respondent No. 2 has also placed on

record judgment passed by this Court in **CWP-22918-2016** titled as **Anshu V/s. State of Haryana and another**, whereby this issue has been examined in detail and it has been held that in a case where a candidate himself violates the terms and conditions of the answer sheet, he cannot turn around and challenge the instructions. Hence, the candidatures of the petitioners have been rightly rejected. Moreover, final result for the post of VLDA has been declared on 13.01.2020 and after declaration of the final result all the selected candidates have already joined.

Hence, no case to interfere in the final result is made out.

Dismissed.
