On 03.02.2020, learned counsel for the appellants had stated that the appellants were not agreeing to the proposal of Rs.5 lakhs that had been made on 16.12.2019 more, over and above the amount already awarded by the MACT. Therefore, notice was issued to the appellants to appear in person before us today i.e. 17.02.2020.

Today, appellant No.1 is present before us and parties have settled the matter by compromise whereby the appellants have agreed to accept the additional compensation of Rs. 5,50,000/- instead of Rs. 5,00,000/- as stated in the proposal. Learned counsel for the Insurance Company has also agreed to accept the counter offer of the appellants. Their statements to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹5,50,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs fifty thousand only) in the name of the appellant No.1-Hema wife of Sunil, who would receive the amount of Rs.5,50,000/- on behalf of all the appellants, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.03.2020 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
