Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles
226/227 of the Constitution of India directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect
their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4, who is husband of
petitioner No.1.

Petitioners No.2 and 3 are parents while petitioners No.4 and 5 are
brothers of petitioner No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that
representation dated 11.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) has already been moved by the
petitioners to respondent No.2 in this regard, but police failed to take any
action. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the petitioners
would be satisfied, if necessary directions be given to respondent No.2 to
dispose of the aforesaid representation, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramandeep Sandhu, Sr. DAG, Punjab has accepted notice on
behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel has no objection, if the necessary directions as stated above is given to respondent No.2.

Accordingly, without going into the merit of this case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-SSP, Rupnagar to examine and decide the representation dated 11.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law and to do the needful, in case any threat perception was found in this case.
