1. This petition has been filed seeking to challenge the order 09.08.2019 of maintenance as passed by the Family Court, Rajpura in proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C.
2. Counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that during the pendency of the proceedings in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court the matter has been amicably resolved by way of a settlement/agreement dated 18.12.2019 in which it has been decided that the parties would file a first petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and an amount of Rs.4,50,000/- would be paid as full and final settlement towards past, present, future maintenance and permanent alimony of the wife. It has also been agreed that the respondent/wife who has filed an execution petition titled as “Neha Vs. Sandeep Kumar” before the Addl. Principle Judge, Family Court, Rajpura would withdraw the same.

3. Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent does not dispute the factum of compromise having arrived at between the parties and has no objection in case the instant petition is allowed and the impugned order of maintenance is set aside.

The petition is accordingly allowed and the order of maintenance as passed by the Family Court, Rajpura is herein set aside.
