The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, the private respondents are not accepting their marriage and are adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, petitioners have moved a representation dated 15.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Panchkula.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Vishal Malik, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. He on instructions from ASI Didar Singh, Police Post Ramgarh, submits that statement of petitioner No.1 has already been recorded wherein she has stated that she is residing with petitioner No.2 at the given address and she is not facing any threat perception from the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.5 to 8.

In view of above, the instant petition has become infructuous and is disposed of as such.
