This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 7 dated 14.8.2019 under Sections 120-B, 177,, 181, 409, 417, 420, 466, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 13 (1) (C) and 13 (1) (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act registered at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau Gurugram.

Petitioner was allowed interim protection vide order dated 28.11.2019. Previously, vide order dated 9.11.2019, the arrest of the petitioner was stayed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Ram Karan, states that the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 28.11.2019 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
