Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-7) dated 28.12.2020, in this regard, to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (Punjab).

On asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

Petitioners have placed on record copies of their Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) respectively as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage certificate (Annexure P-6).

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana (Punjab), to look into the representation Annexure P-7 dated 28.12.2020 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
