(1) The present writ petition has been filed by petitioner Vikramjit Singh and 7 others, *inter alia* praying for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to shift meritorious candidates of reserved categories [BC & SC (R&O)] to general vacancies and appoint them against vacancies in their own reserved categories to the post of Intelligence Assistants (in the rank of Constable).

(2) The record shows that notice of motion was issued on 17.01.2018. Reply by way of affidavit was filed by Sh. Satinderpal Singh, PPS, Assistant Inspector General of Police, HQ, Intelligence, Punjab on 12.02.2019.

(3) CM-4104-CWP-2020 has been filed wherein it has been *inter alia* pleaded that during the pendency of the writ petition, the official respondents have already given appointment to petitioners No.3 to 8 to the post of Intelligence Assistants (Constables) in the Intelligence Wing, Punjab. It is further averred that petitioners No.3 to 8 have joined their services after completing all the formalities. As regards petitioners No.1 & 2, they had also

been appointed and had joined and the writ petition qua them was withdrawn, as noticed vide order dated 09.07.2018.

(4) In this view of the matter, learned counsel prays that the present writ petition may be permitted to withdrawn *qua* petitioners No.3 to 8 as well.

(5) Accordingly, the application is allowed and the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn as no further orders are called for.
