In the present writ petition, challenge is to the order dated 26.03.2013 (Annexure P-1) by which respondent No. 5 was promoted as Service Station Incharge and also to the order dated 15.05.2014 (Annexure P-3) by which claim of the petitioner for promotion to the said post being senior to respondent No. 5 has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the respondents by placing reliance upon reply filed to the writ petition states that the impugned order of promotion of respondent No. 5 as Service Station Incharge has already been withdrawn by the authorities on 01.10.2018 and, therefore, the plea that a person junior to the petitioner has been promoted as Service Station Incharge, has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view

the reply filed by the respondents, petitioner be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one in case any right accrues in favour of the petitioner after the decision of CWP No. 26566 of 2018, which has been filed by respondent No. 5.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty, as prayed for.
