[1] Result of the petitioner has been produced in sealed cover in Court today which on opening reveals the petitioner to have secured 108 marks out of 200 marks as against 113/117 marks of the last selected candidate for the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 for UHBVNL/DHBVNL under General Category. However, last candidate shown in the waiting list for the abovementioned post has secured 100/110 marks.

[2] Result of the petitioner as well as cut-off marks of the last selected candidate have been shown to the learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal states that the writ petition may be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow-up action in view of the result of the petitioner.

[3] Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondents to take follow-up action in view of the result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk against Advt. No.3/2016, Category No.03 of UHBVNL/DHBVNL in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
