JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The aforesaid contempt stood disposed of vide order dated 24.5.2018 passed by this Court in the light of unconditional apologies tendered and accepted on behalf of all the respondents-contemners, who happened to be practicing Advocates at Tohana.

The Hon'ble Court while disposing off the contempt had directed the Bar Council to submit an action taken report in the light of the alleged conducts amounting to misconduct under the Advocates Act, 1949, so as to curb the growing tendency of the Advocates to go on strike etc., and thereby cause hindrance in the dispensation of justice.

In compliance, Mr. Birinder Singh Rana, Senior Advocate submits that a report dated 01.12.2019 submitted by the Disciplinary Committee of the Bar Council of Punjab & Haryana stands submitted with direction to the said lawyers to follow the stated instructions. The respective Bar Association have also been directed to take steps to ensure that no undue protests are made.

Keeping in view the totality of circumstances and the action taken report, we find no reasons to carry on with the present proceedings.
