Petitioner seeks grant of necessary permission to go
abroad for a period of two months for business purpose.

Petitioner is an accused in case bearing FIR No.217
dated 06.08.2016 registered under Sections 148/149/323/
325/341/506 IPC at Police Station Ladwa District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that
petitioner is an NRI and is resident of Italy since 1998. He came
to India on account of illness of his father on 19.04.2016 and

was involved in the present case. Petitioner has 4 acres of land besides, two houses owned by him. Petitioner is ready to execute bank guarantee in a sum of Rs.20 lakhs as a condition precedent for allowing him to go abroad for a period of two months. Petitioner undertakes to return well in time so as to face the trial in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel submitted that 16.05.2020 is the date fixed for further proceedings before the trial Court.

In view of above, subject to the aforesaid condition of executing bank guarantee in a sum of Rs.20 lakh to the satisfaction of the trial Court, the petitioner is permitted to go abroad for a period of two months. Normal consequences to follow.
