LISA GILL, J.

This petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to allow the petitioner to operate the bank accounts of Shri Guru Ravidass Charitable Trust. The petitioner projects himself to be the acting Chairman of the said Trust in the memo of parties. There is, however, no averment in this respect in the petition. In para 9 of the petition, it is stated that the petitioner is an authorised signatory of the Trust.

This petition was adjourned to 23.09.2019 to enable filing of a specific affidavit of the petitioner clarifying the exact and precise authority he holds in the Shri Guru Ravidass Charitable Trust and also to depose that as on date there was no pending dispute, whatsoever, amongst the members of the Trust. Affidavit dated 18.10.2019 was filed pursuant thereto. The petitioner in the said affidavit claims to be the son of Sh. Dogar Ram, former President of Shri Guru Ravidass Charitable Trust and states that the petitioner's father has become very old and is not very active and that being the position, the petitioner was made an active member of the Trust and has been duly authorised. There is no detail whatsoever forthcoming, in this affidavit, in terms of order dated 23.09.2019.

I do not find any justification for keeping the present writ petition pending any longer.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

The petitioner, however, is at liberty to file afresh, if so advised, with the necessary details and particulars.
