B.S. WALIA, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of regularization policy of the year 2014, on the basis of which relief is claimed for by the petitioner, having already been struck down by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.17206 of 2014, in case titled as Yogesh Tyagi and another vs. State of Haryana and others, on 31.05.2018, he does not press the writ petition at this stage. However, learned counsel prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings in the eventuality of revival of the policy by Hon'ble the Supreme Court or any other order on the basis of which the petitioner can maintain the claim for regularization.

2. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
