3. No tangible grounds are made out for releasing the petitioner, at this stage, since the trial has already in progress; 01 out of the 09 prosecution witnesses has already been examined and the matter is now stated to be pending for further evidence on the 18th of this month.

4. The prayer for bail, in the circumstances, is rejected, with a direction upon the Ld. Trial Court to make endeavour to complete the trial as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of four months from the date of communication of this order.

5. It is further made clear that in case, the presence of any official witnesses is not secured by the prosecution promptly, the Ld. Trial Court would be at liberty to dispense with the evidence of such witness.
