Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.44 dated 15.05.2017, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC.

There is an allegation that the petitioner has embezzled the amount of more than Rs.30 lakh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was arrested on 30.07.2018; challan was presented on 27.11.2018 and charges were framed on 26.03.2019. Out of 31 prosecution witnesses, only 02 witnesses have been examined. Learned counsel draws the attention of this Court towards the status report (Annexure P-12) wherein it has been mentioned that building committee members and other

officials had also withdrawn the amount for construction of building.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the first petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail was dismissed as withdrawn on 02.07.2019. Moreover, three material witnesses i.e. Rajnish Sharma, Harbhupinder Singh and Dr. Suresh Bansal, are yet to be examined.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

Since the matter has been pending before the trial Court since 27.11.2018, trial Court is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.
