This is a petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 22.05.2019, registered under Sections 323, 34, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women, Sector 51, Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations as set out in the FIR are not sustainable and the petitioner was ready to join the investigation.

By an order dated 18.09.2019, the petitioner had been asked to join the investigation.

Counsel for the respondent-State submits that though the petitioner was directed to join the investigation, but she did not come forth.

However, in the meantime, challan has been presented and the petitioner herein has been dropped from all proceedings.

In view of the above, since the challan has already been presented and the name of the petitioner herein has been put in column No.2, the petition in hand stands rendered infructuous.

No further orders are called for.
