The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.20 dated 30.07.2019, under Sections 420, 427, 448, 511, 506, 380, 120-B IPC, Police Station NRI, District Hoshiarpur.

On 19.09.2019, this Court had issued notice of motion and the petitioner was directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks and in the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer and further that he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh,

has stated that in compliance with the order dated 19.09.2019, the petitioner has already surrendered and joined the investigation and is fully cooperating with the same. He has further stated that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.09.2019 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.
