This application has been filed by both, the applicants-appellants in the accompanying petition, as also by respondent no. 3, i.e. the insurance company as was liable to pay the compensation to the appellants claimants.

An early date of hearing in the accompanying appeal is sought by the applicants, on the ground that the matter had been amicably compromised between the parties, with Rs. 6,50,000/- to be paid to the appellants by way of enhanced compensation, over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Gurugram.

Since learned counsel for both the parties are appearing, the application is allowed and the date of hearing in the accompanying appeal is advanced to today itself.
