In compliance of order dated 29.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners have produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.0259 dated 20.04.2017, registered under Sections 323, 447, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Samalkhan, District Panipat (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 19.09.2019 of the Coordinate Bench, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 07.01.2020 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Smalkha, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.16 dated 09.01.2020, duly

forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Panipat, vide Endst. No.886 dated 13.01.2020.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in between the parties, FIR No.0259 dated 20.04.2017, registered under Sections 323, 447, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Samalkhan, District Panipat (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters.
