1. Vide this common order we shall dispose of above said four writ petitions as the common question of law and facts are involved

therein. For the sake of convenience, facts are being taken from CWP-27727-2019.

2. This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondent No.3 for entertainment of written submissions dated 21.5.2019 filed vide Annexure P-4 and reminder dated 18.6.2019 (Annexure P-8).

3. Briefly, the petitioner has challenged the action of the respondent taken for cancellation of the Form C.

4. Today, learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from Randhir Singh, ETO, Panipat has stated that respondent No.4 will pass a order with regard to the cancellation, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

5. In the circumstances, the petitions stand disposed of. The parties through counsel are directed to appear before the respondent No.4 on 26.2.2020 who shall pass an order thereon within one month thereafter.

6. Since the main cases have been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
