After arguing at length, learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant may be permitted to approach the respondent-authorities to refund the remaining part of security lying with them after adjustment of the amount that is due from the appellant as per the impugned order.

While we do not find any reason to interfere with the order passed by the learned Single Judge, the liberty as prayed for is granted permitting the appellant to approach the authorities seeking refund of the remaining amount of security, if any, lying with the respondents.

The appeal accordingly stands disposed of.

No orders are required to be passed in CM-4451-LPA-2019 for leading additional evidence by way of filing a copy of the letter dated 19.04.2016 of the Government of India, Department of Food & Public Distribution (Annexure A-1).
