1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.93, dated 8.3.2019, Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 323, 365, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 19.9.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal, has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Lokesh @ Loki, Dharamchand @ Dharmender,

Sunil, Rajeev and also of complainant Vikas have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant in his statement has specifically stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.93, dated 8.3.2019, Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, under Sections 323, 365, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
