This order will dispose off two criminal petitions i.e. CRM-M-40248 and 40274-2019 as both are filed for quashing FIR No.65 dated 13.06.1999 under Sections 354, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur. Brief facts of the case are taken from CRM-M-40248-2019.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.65 dated 13.06.1999 under Sections 354, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise

(Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Vide order dated 07.11.2019 of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 10.12.2019 to get their statements recorded regarding the compromise arrived at, between them.

Report dated 08.01.2020 has since been received from the learned SDJM, Garhshankar in pursuance to the direction of this Court. As per the report, none of the parties appeared before the Court to make their statements with regard to compromise.

Hence, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
