This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for seeking permission to withdraw the present petition.

Prayer in this present petition is for quashing of impugned order dated 10.01.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad, whereby the opportunity to cross-examine the respondent-DW1 has been closed by the Court order and to allow the petitioner to cross-examine the respondent DW-1.

While issuing notice of motion, the petitioner was directed to pay cost of Rs. 20,000/- to the respondent-Ashok Kumar and the *dasti* notice was also issued.

As per office report, notice could not be issued to the respondent as no document regarding payment of Rs. 20,000/- was filed.

Even though the notice was not issued to the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioner states that after receiving the amount of Rs. 20,000/- in the trial Court, the respondent has been cross examined on 03.10.2019 and thus the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition having been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.
