[1] Result of the petitioner in the General Category for the post of Lower Division Clerk in UHBVNL/DHBVNL advertisement No.03/2016, Category No.03, has been produced in Court in a sealed cover along with the marks obtained by the last selected candidate/last candidate on the waiting list.

[2] Result on opening reveals petitioner to have secured 105 marks, whereas last selected candidate in the UHBVNL/DHBVNL has obtained 113/117 marks while the last candidate on the waiting list secured 100/110 marks respectively in UHBVNL/DHBVNL.

[3] In the light of the position as noted above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the writ petition be disposed of by directing the respondents to take follow up action on the result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk in the UHBVNL, in accordance with law.

[4] Learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

[5] In the light of the position as noted above, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the respondents to take follow up action on the result of the petitioner for the post of Lower Division Clerk, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, within a period of 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
