Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0026 dated 10.04.2019 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

On 20.09.2019, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Counsel for the petitioner states that the deceased- Balveer Kaur was mother-in-law of Jaswinder Singh. Jaswinder Singh is the son of complainant-Sucha Singh. The petitioner is none else but a neighbour as well as in family relation of the deceased. It has been alleged that there was some dispute, but the dispute, if any, was not of such nature, by which, the deceased can go to the extent of committing suicide. No motive or allegation has been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 09.01.2020.

Meanwhile, till the next date of hearing, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Najar Singh, has informed this Court that in the aforesaid FIR, police has investigated the matter and has prepared cancellation report.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, the order dated 20.09.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
