In compliance of order dated 05.02.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.651 dated 12.11.2017, registered under Sections 186, 332, 353 IPC, at Police Station Meham (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 20.09.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 29.10.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Meham has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.534 dated 05.11.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Rohtak, vide Endst. No.5737 dated 08.11.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and without coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.651 dated 12.11.2017, registered under Sections 186, 332, 353 IPC, at Police Station Meham (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
