Prayer in this application is for recalling of the order dated 30.01.2020 on the ground that the absence of Counsel for the petitioner on 30.01.2020 was not intentional or deliberate.

Ld. Counsel for the non-applicant/respondent submits that he has no objection if the petitioner's prayer in the main revision petition is allowed subject to causing of some costs instead of reviving the stay.

On the request of both the Counsels, the main revision petition is taken up on Board, for consideration, today itself.

CRR No.2517 of 2019 (O&M)

Ld. Counsel for the respondent submits that his client has no objection to cross-examination of the complainant as sought for in the

main revision petition provided, it is done on behalf of the petitioner on the very next date already fixed before the Ld. Trial Court, which happens to be 12.02.2020, and, therefore, seeks appropriate order/direction.

2. In view of the aforesaid submission, the main revision petition is disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner, subject to payment of costs of Rs.3000/-, to positively cross-examine the complainant on the date already fixed in the Ld. Trial Court, failing which, no further indulgence shall be granted to him.

3. In view of the final disposal of the main revision petition, all the pending miscellaneous applications shall stand disposed off.
