The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.477 dated 27.07.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 341 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Assandh.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. He is stated to have fired four rounds from his licenced revolver at victim Amarjit Singh, which resulted in his death and also injuries to Manjeet Singh on his chest/arm near the shoulder, which appears to have pierced through his body. The injury on Manjeet Singh was opined as dangerous to life.

One of the ground while praying for bail was that the trial has been stayed in the revision petition filed by Palwinder Singh, who has challenged the order dated 21.04.2018 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal, summoning him under Section 319 Cr.P.C. and Manjit Singh, whose application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. in the FIR case was dismissed.

In view of the revision petitions bearing CRR-28-2018 and CRR-3238-2018 having been disposed of by an order of even date, the said ground is no more available as the trial Court is now free to proceed with the trial.

Dismissed accordingly.
