[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing order, Annexure P/3 dated 18.09.2019 transferring the petitioner from IMT Manesar to Infrastructure Planning Division, Head Office, Panchkula contrary to the principles of natural justice and policy instructions, Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2004.

[2] While issuing notice of motion interim stay of impugned order, Annexure P/3 dated 18.09.2019 was passed.

[3] Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 states that the petitioner had already served at IMT, Manesar for more than five years prior to his transfer to Panchkula and that since the Annual General Transfers are due in March/April, 2020, the writ petition be disposed of by allowing the petitioner to continue at IMT, Manesar till the time of the Annual General Transfers whereupon a fresh decision would be taken as per

law/in accordance with the policy as to whether the petitioner is to be continued at IMT, Manesar or to be transferred elsewhere.

[4] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of. The petitioner shall be allowed to continue at IMT, Manesar till the time of Annual General Transfers in March/April, 2020 whereupon a fresh decision would be taken by the competent authority in accordance with the policy/as per law as to whether the petitioner is to be continued at IMT, Manesar or transferred elsewhere.

[6] This order shall also dispose all the pending misc. applications.
