Petitioner-Surinder Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 07.07.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Payal, District Khanna. The petitioner apprehended her arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

The FIR was registered on the allegations that Babli Sood (complainant) was pursuing the litigation against her husband when a boy met her in the Court and offered his help in settling the dispute. The said boy started visiting the house of the complainant and stole essential documents

from her house. On 02.04.2019, the said boy (Gurvir Singh) alongwith his mother and another person entered the house of the complainant and gave beatings to her and her mother. When the matter reached Police Station, he showed marriage certificate prepared from Gurudwara Ghudanbi Sahib showing complainant's marriage with him. As per the prosecution, the petitioner facilitated the preparation of the fake marriage certificate.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner on 24.09.2019, notice of motion was issued for 13.02.2020 and the interim protection was extended with a direction to the petitioner to join the investigation subject to the conditions contained in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State who is assisted by SI Amrik Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant has pointed out that four other cases are registered against the petitioner, who has been arrested recently in one of those cases.

At this stage, learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner was arrested on 08.02.2020 in FIR No.1 dated 01.01.2020 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 451, 380, 447, 323, 511 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to justify the conduct of the petitioner as she failed to join the investigation for a long time after getting the concession on 24.09.2019.

Considering the above background and conduct of the petitioner, this Court finds that this is not a fit a case for grant of extra ordinary concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
