This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100 dated 16.07.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran. The petitioner apprehended her arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 01.10.2019 whereby the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 10.09.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-35947-2019.

To be heard along with CRM-M-35947-2019 on 11.12.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted herself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Narinder does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned counsel on instructions from ASI Narinder further states that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being. However, he also states that accused, namely, Raman Kumar for whose release, the alleged forged medical certificate was prepared, has now been taken into custody.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 01.10.2019 is made absolute.
