ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J.

Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to take action on the representation dated 08.08.2019 (Annexure P-1), addressed to the Director General of Police, Punjab.

A perusal of the representation (Annexure P-1) shows that the petitioner had made a request that he may be granted permission to keep the arms licence, as he made a complaint against DSP (D) and SHO, Police Station Kharar and later on, a compromise was effected. It is further stated that aforesaid officials are giving threats to him and respondent No.6 Jarnail Singh Bajwa is an influential person, having political connections. A perusal of the representation further shows that primary grievance of the petitioner is to allow him to keep the arms licence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhag Singh, has submitted that even respondent No.6 has also gave a representation to the DGP and now the matter has been referred to SP, HQ, Fatehgarh Sahib to investigate and inquire into the same. It is further submitted that SP, HQ, Fatehgarh Sahib has issued notice to the petitioner on three occasions, but he is not appearing and has communicated to the Inquiry Officer that he is not well and will appear later on and has also sought 15 days more time.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, as the matter is under inquiry with a senior police officer and it will be open for the petitioner to join the inquiry.

Accordingly, the present petition is rendered as infructuous.
